**INFORMATIVE MOTION OF THE
OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF RETIRED EMPLOYEES
OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO REGARDING
PARTICIPATION IN THE DECEMBER 14, 2017 HEARING**

The Official Committee of Retired Employees of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico (the “**Retiree Committee**”) hereby submits this informational motion in response to this Court’s *Order and Notice of Hearing* [Dkt. No. 1877], and respectfully states as follows:

1. Richard Levin will appear on behalf of the Retiree Committee at the December 14, 2017 hearing in Courtroom #8 of the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts, One Courthouse Way, Boston, Massachusetts 02210 and present argument in in connection with the *Urgent Renewed Joint Motion by the Ad Hoc Group of General Obligation Bondholders*,
