**INFORMATIVE MOTION OF THE
OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF RETIRED EMPLOYEES

The Official Committee of Retired Employees of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico (the “**Retiree Committee**”) hereby submits this informative motion in response to this Court’s *Order Regarding Procedures for Attendance, Participation and Observation of the March 7-8, 2018 Omnibus Hearing* [Dkt.
